STEPS:

1. Apply Online

- Complete the online application form, including all necessary personal and golf-related information.
- Upload any required documents (letters of recommendations, transcripts, etc.).

2. Speak with a Recruiter

 A recruiter will reach out to discuss your application, answer any questions or concerns, and guide you through the next steps. They will also provide an overview of your educational options and academy expectations.

3. Receive Enrollment Information Packet

 After your conversation with a recruiter, you will receive a packet containing helpful information about the admissions process, golf program information, financial details, and educational partnerships.

4. Schedule a Site Visit or Take a Virtual Tour

 If you would like to experience the academy firsthand, you can schedule an on-site visit or a shadow day. (Optional) Alternatively, check out our Virtual Tour to explore the facilities online.

5. Apply to Educational Partner

- Option 1: Apply to Holston Academy
- Send official transcripts to the Director of Academics and follow their admissions process.
- Option 2: Apply to Wooster School
- Apply directly to Wooster School *2 year commitment*
- Inform the GPA staff once your application to Wooster has been sent and accepted.

6. Duolingo/TOEFL Test (for International Students)

 International students must complete either the Duolingo (minimum score 95) or TOEFL test (minimum score 59) as part of the admissions requirements.

7. Secure Your Spot with a Deposit

- After acceptance, the Financial Department will reach out with payment details.
- A **\$5,000 non-refundable deposit** is required to secure your place in the Academy.

8. Receive Acceptance and Welcome Packet

 Once all steps are completed and verified, you will receive an Official Welcome Letter and an Information Packet with details about your enrollment, training schedule, and next steps.
